They are things we call worldly that require solutions of this world. What is needed here is basic common sense helping to deal with it by reason alone, and thus together find fair solutions. It is true that the Gospel should serve us with inspiration, but many solutions can be reached with our own effort, with reflection that leads to the community's benefit.

The person in this parable is preoccupied and seeks to plan for his future. And he seems to finally have found the solution, considering that in following his plan, his welfare is assured.
