The prophet Amos is called by God to speak to his people. He is not comfortable with his vocation, but he responds to God in a serious manner and fulfills the mission of denouncing the sins of the people and announcing the plan of God to a people who has difficulty in listening. His words as prophet turn out to be unbearable to the powerful people of his time, who saw in him a simple visionary. Paul begins a hymn of thanksgiving and praise to God for his selection and the blessings received. In Christ, our creator and Father adopts us as his children and promises us an inestimable inheritance granted to all the baptized. Jesus began the work God assigned to him by announcing the Kingdom of God. He was the great preacher sent by God. The fruit of his complete surrender to God is our salvation. Up until now the disciples have accompanied him on his travels through Galilee, but the hour of the proclamation of the Gospel has arrived and sends them to spread his message and to work even more. With these words of wisdom, he teaches us what kind of person the bearer of the Good News of God to humanity should be: without human certainty, without obligations to anyone, but rather respecting their freedom and at the same time emphasizing the importance of the Gospel.
