IT IS THE LORD

The gospel passage this Sunday narrates the encounter of the Risen Jesus with a group of seven disciples and, in a special way, with Simon Peter. After the miraculous catch of fish the disciples recognize the Lord. They had worked hard all night with no success whatsoever in their struggle to catch fish. The load of fish that was successfully caught was a sign of their mission: they were now fisher of men. The fishing net represented the Church which embraces all peoples of the earth. The number 153, the quantity of fish in the burgeoning net represented the enormous fertility of their work as Apostles of Jesus Christ, but there is a secret: they must constantly search for the presence of Jesus and receive the nourishment of the Word of Jesus.

The disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter: It is the Lord. The disciple represents all true disciples who may be the object of the personal love of Jesus and at the same time responds to that love with his own love in return.
